

<b>Regulatory Signs</b>		
	<b>STOP</b> 12" X 12" Octagon – red/white Instructs riders to bring their OHRV to a COMPLETE STOP	
	<b>ATVs, UTVs and TRAILBIKES PROHIBITED</b> 12" X 12" Square – orange/black Identifies areas where OHRV traffic is NOT allowed. (Typically installed where spurs leave a trail.)	
	<b>NO SNOWMOBILES</b> 12" X 12" Square – orange/black Identifies trails where snowmobiles are NOT allowed.	
	<b>NO MOTORIZED WHEELED VEHICLES</b> 12" X 12" Square – orange/black Identifies trails where wheeled vehicles are NOT allowed.	
	<b>NO HIGHWAY VEHICLES ALLOWED</b> 12" X 12" Square – orange/black Identifies trails where highway vehicles are NOT allowed.	
	<b>OHRV PERMITTED</b> 9" X 12" Extended Diamond – white/green Identifies trails where ATVs/UTVs ARE allowed	
	<b>SNOWMOBILES PERMITTED</b> 9" X 12" Extended Diamond – orange/black Identifies trails where snowmobiles ARE allowed	












## Trail Marker Signs

	<p><b>DIRECTIONAL MARKER</b> 8" X 8" Extended Diamond – orange/black Used to show trail direction in areas where riders could venture off designated trail.</p>	
	<p><b>TRAIL BLAZE</b> 5" X 7" Extended Diamond – orange/black Informs riders they are on a designated trail.</p>	
	<p><b>CORRIDOR TRAIL</b> 8" X 9" Rectangle – white/green Placed at entrances to corridor trails with the number and direction of travel printed in the white area with a paint pen.</p>	
	<p><b>PRIMARY TRAIL</b> 7" X 7" Square – white/green Used to inform riders that the trail connects to a Corridor Trail. The number will correspond to the number on the NHSA Snowmobile Trail map.</p>	

## Informational Signs






	<p><b>TRAIL INFORMATION</b> 6" X 8" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders of where they are, how far to gas, who maintains the trail, how far to parking, etc.</p>	
	<p><b>STAY ON TRAIL OR STAY HOME</b> 6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black Many landowners request riders to ride in a specific area.</p>	
	<p><b>DEAD END DO NOT ENTER</b> 6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders that there is no outlet on trail; trail ends.</p>	
	<p><b>STAY ON TRAIL OR LOSE IT</b> 6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders to stay on the trail or risk it being closed.</p>	
	<p><b>TRAIL HEAD</b> 9" X 12" Diamond – white/green Used when new trail is started, at the beginning of a trail from parking areas, or to indicate the trailhead across a large open field. Reminds riders that their registration fees pay for New Hampshire's Snowmobile trail system.</p>	
	<p><b>LANDOWNERS</b> 12" X 12" Square – white/black Used as a public relations tool between clubs and landowners. Advises trail users that they are on private property and should "RESPECT IT."</p>	
	<p><b>TRAIL PARKING TO LEFT</b> 12" X 24" Rectangle – white/green Placed at the entrance to approved parking areas. Informs riders to go to the left to reach OHRV parking.</p>	
	<p><b>TRAIL PARKING TO RIGHT</b> 12" X 24" Rectangle – white/green Placed at the entrance to approved parking areas. Informs riders to go to the right to reach OHRV parking.</p>	

## Warning Signs

	<b>STOP AHEAD</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black/red Informs riders that they are approaching a STOP sign.	
	<b>TRAIL TEMPORARILY CLOSED</b> <b>Note: this sign is limited to 5/club/year.</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders that they are approaching a temporarily closed area and should not proceed.	Limit to 5 max
	<b>GATE AHEAD</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down as they are approaching a gate across the trail.	
	<b>BRIDGE AHEAD</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down as they are approaching a bridge crossing.	
	<b>LOGGING AHEAD</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down, could encounter heavy equipment & trucks.	
	<b>JUNCTION AHEAD</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down, a trail junction is up ahead.	
	<b>RIGHT or LEFT TURN</b> 12" X 12" Square – yellow/black Informs riders that the trail ahead makes significant changes in direction.	
	<b>SLOW</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Instructs riders to slow their vehicle.	
	<b>PLANTATION</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders they are entering a tree plantation and should stay on the trail.	
	<b>WATCH FOR GROOMERS</b> 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders they should be aware of groomers being used on the trail.	
	<b>OBJECT (Hazard) MARKER</b> 7" X 7" Square – yellow/black. Identifies a fixed object at the side of the trail. (Used any time the fixed object narrows the normal width of trail.	

## Speed Limit Signs

**Note: Speed limit signs are only available with Bureau of Trails District Supervisor approval of location and quantity. Contact them directly for details.**

	<b>10 MPH SNOWMOBILE with PICTURE</b> 12" X 18" Rectangle – white/black Informs riders they should be going no more than 10 MPH.
	<b>20 MPH SNOWMOBILE with PICTURE</b> 12" X 18" Rectangle – white/black Informs riders they should be going no more than 20 MPH.
	<b>BLANK MPH SNOWMOBILE SPEED LIMIT</b> 12" X 12" Square – white/black Informs riders they should be going no more than the speed indicated.
	<b>10 MPH SNOWMOBILE SPEED LIMIT</b> 12" X 12" Square – white/black Informs riders they should be going no more than 10 MPH.
	<b>45 MPH SNOWMOBILE SPEED LIMIT</b> 12" X 12" Square – white/black Informs riders they should be going no more than 45 MPH.
