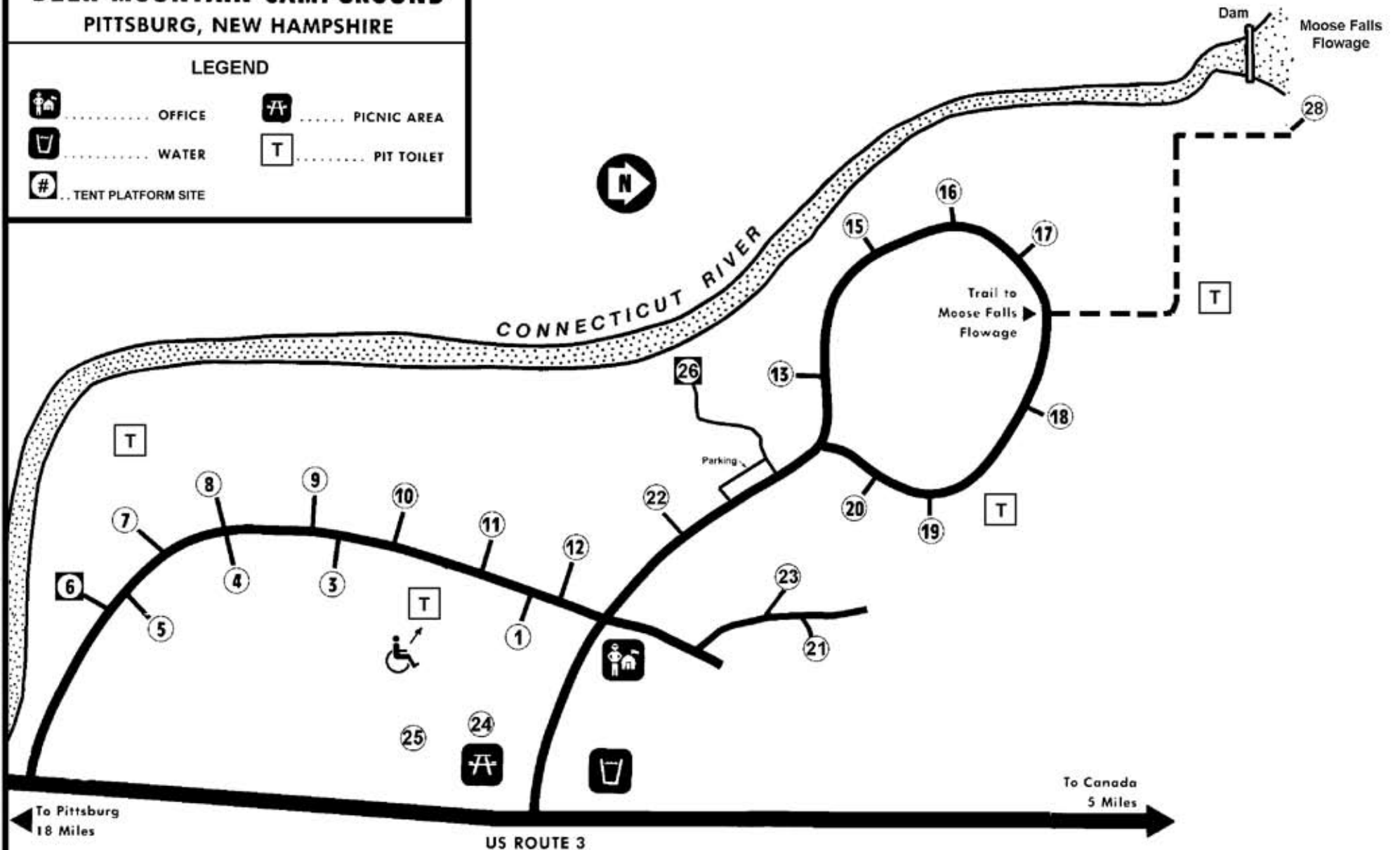

# Deer Mountain Campground

## Lake Francis State Park

### About the Campground

This primitive campground is located in Connecticut Lakes State Forest, between the Second and Third Connecticut Lakes, just five miles south of the Canadian border. The 25-site campground is thirteen miles from Lake Francis, and is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend.

### Facilities, Services and Amenities

Each site has a fireplace, picnic table, a flat area for a tent, and a parking space. Showers and laundry facilities are available at Lake Francis State Park. Water is not available after mid-October.

### Activities

The campground is adjacent to the stretch of Route 3 north of Pittsburg, referred to as Moose Alley, which makes it a prime location for moose viewing. Fishing and hiking are also enjoyed.

### About the Policies

- Check in time is between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out is 11 am.
- If the campground office is not open upon arrival, campers should register at the self-registration station. Please fill in the information requested on the envelope provided, enclose the fee, and deposit in the designated slot.
- The Park accepts cash, vouchers, money orders, or traveler's checks only.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Pets are permitted in the campground, but must be leashed and attended at all times.
- Do not wash dishes or brush teeth at the water stations.
- Cutting standing trees and shrubs and using power saws is prohibited.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. Please do not bring firewood from out-of-state locations.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.

### For Your Safety

Do not invite bears or raccoons into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site by disposing of food waste and scraps properly. Be sure to remove all food items from tables and tents, and secure them in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears..
