



# Umbagog Lake State Park

## Remote Camping Information

The New Hampshire Division of Parks and Recreation manages 34 remote campsites around Umbagog Lake that are not located within the main campground. The sites are generally isolated in wooded areas, accessed only by canoe, kayak, or motorboat. Each site has a fireplace, picnic table, and primitive pit toilet. No drinking water is available, but campers are welcome to fill portable water containers at the main campground.

Both wood and ice are sold in the campground office. Wood must be brought in to all remote campsites. Attention! Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. Please do not bring firewood from out-of-state locations. Gathering wood from anywhere within the park is prohibited. Campfires should be kept small and safe in designated fireplaces, with wood under 16 inches in length, and less than five inches in diameter. Whenever leaving a site unattended, fires must be completely extinguished.

Remote campsites are carry in - carry out. There are no trash cans or provisions for trash pick-up. Campers are responsible for carrying all their trash out with them to dispose of properly. Discourage visits from wildlife by keeping a clean site and disposing of food waste properly.

The maximum number of campers on remote sites is six except on designated group sites (2, 6, 13, 18, 23, 27, 31). Respect the rights and property of site neighbors. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. Pets are welcome on remote sites, but their activity must be restricted, and they must not be left unattended.

transport information  
Canoes and kayaks are available for rent at the main campground. Rental boats may be reserved by calling the campground directly. For a fee, transportation will be provided by campground staff via motorboat. Rates are for two people and gear one way. Each additional person will be charged an additional fee, with a limit of five people per trip. Campers must make transportation arrangements with the campground staff no later than three days prior to arrival. Rates vary according to the site distance from the main campground.
